

MILITARY SCIENCE - CROSS ENROLLMENT

Cross enrollment of students from other colleges or universities in Seattle University military science courses has been allowed since 1967.

- (1) Students enrolled in neighboring colleges or universities which do not offer a military science program are eligible to cross enroll as non-matriculated students at Seattle University with permission of the military science department.
- (2) Enrollment forms and fees are filed with the Office of the Registrar by the military science department. Those students are eliminated from the official enrollment statistics.
- (3) Military science courses are offered on a no-tuition basis, but a fixed fee of \$25 for registration will be charged each student each term of enrollment. No application fee is charged.
- (4) Occasional fees, such as those for removal of an incomplete, apply if the student has elected this option.
- (5) Community college students who have completed military science courses as non-matriculated students at Seattle University and who apply for regular status with no intervening four-year school attendance are allowed a special consideration. Those military science credits may be added to the total of transfer credits from other schools in determining whether or not philosophy and theology waivers may be granted in accordance with Policy #76-12 and #76-14.
