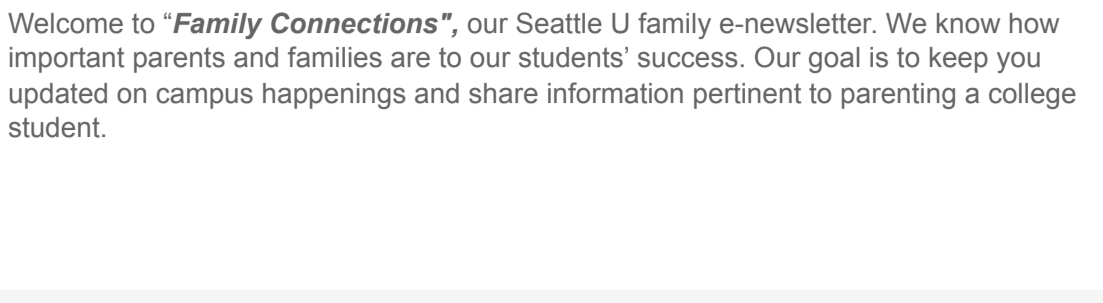

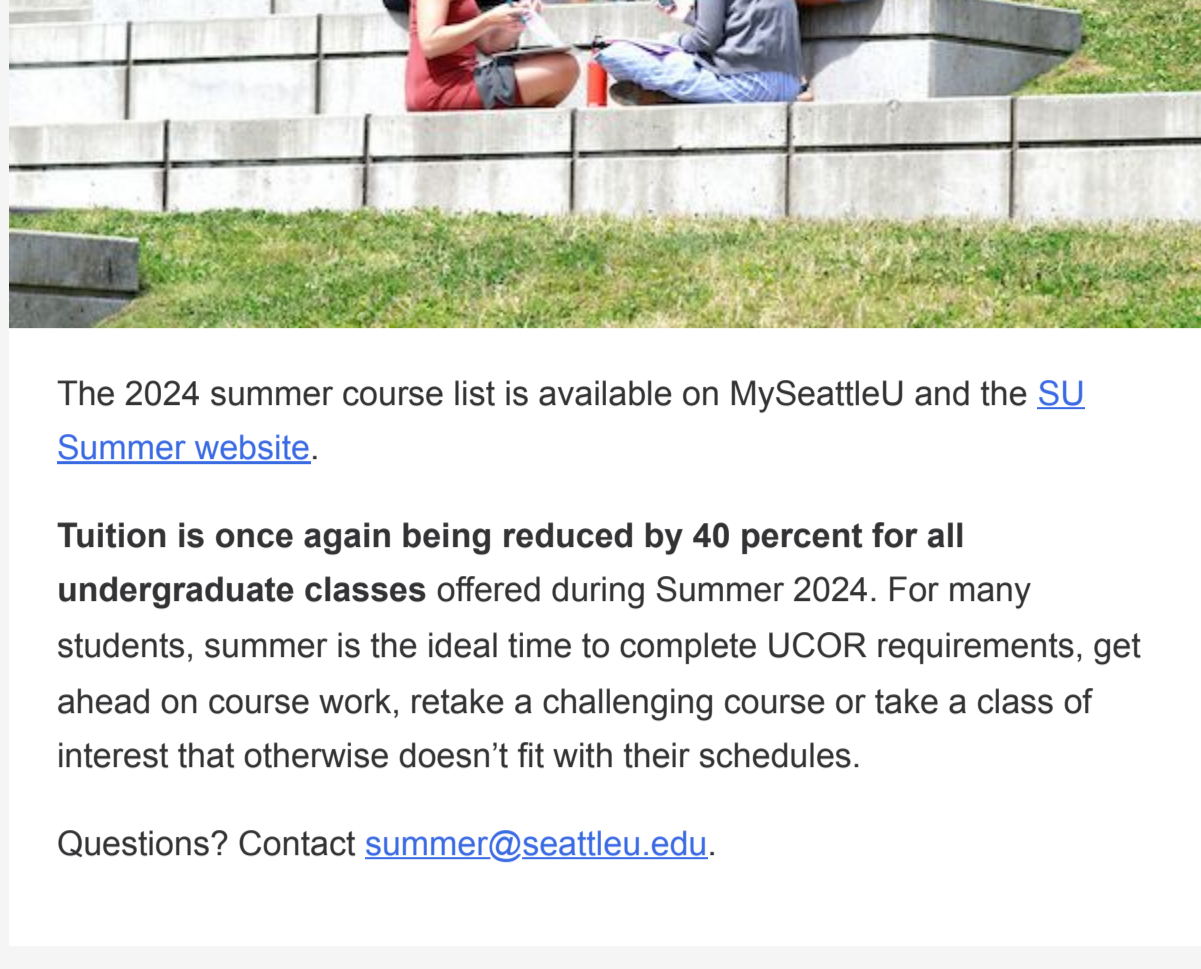

Summer 2024 classes

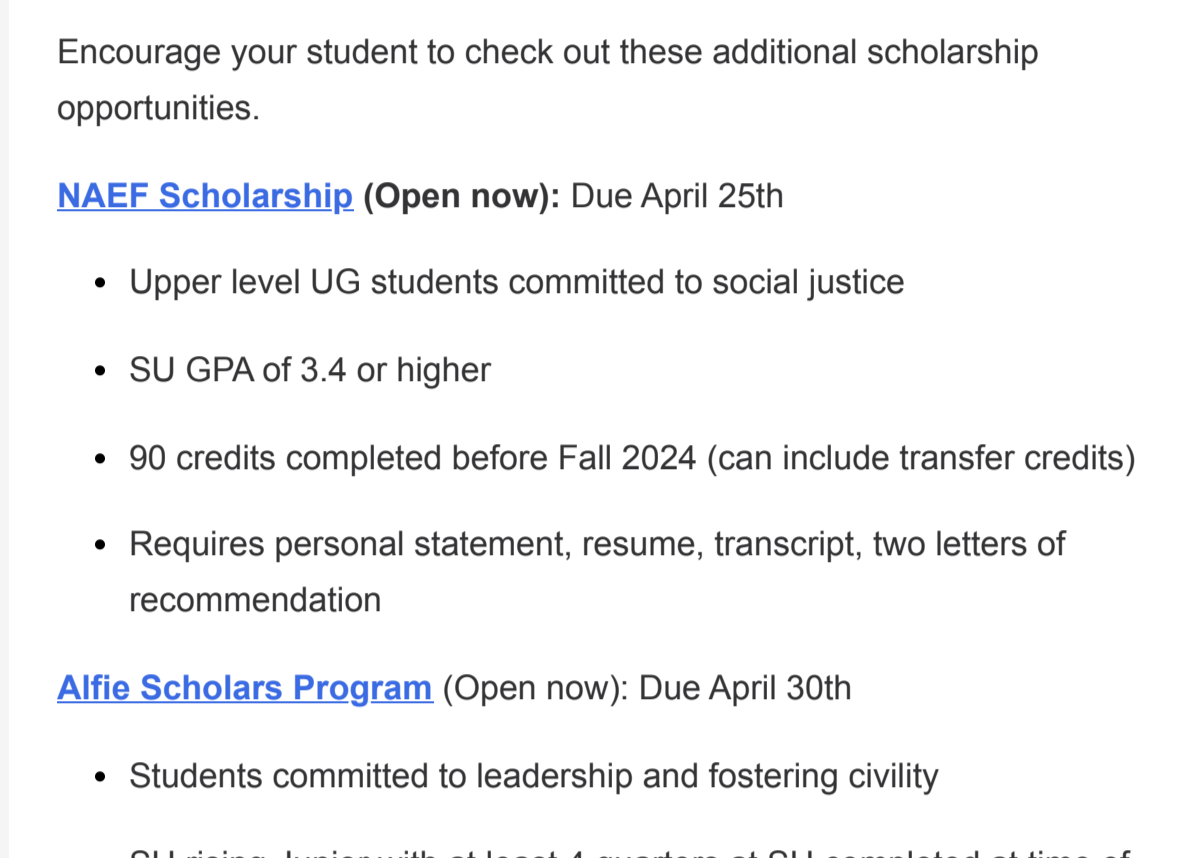


The 2024 summer course list is available on MySeattleU and the [SU Summer website](#).

[NAEF Scholarship](#) (Open now): Due April 25th

- Upper level UG students committed to social justice
- SU GPA of 3.4 or higher
- 90 credits completed before Fall 2024 (can include transfer credits)
- Requires personal statement, resume, transcript, two letters of recommendation

[Alfie Scholars Program](#) (Open now): Due April 30th

- Students committed to leadership and fostering civility
- SU rising Junior with at least 4 quarters at SU completed at time of application (Post-Baccs not eligible)
- Minimum 3.5 GPA
- Requires personal statement, supplemental essays, one letter of recommendation, summer program, summer course

[Albers Departmental Scholarships](#) (Open April 1st in ScholarshipUniverse): Due April 30th

- Requires a short essay
- Additional requirements vary, multiple scholarships available

On-Track Summer Grant program pilot

We recognize that the transition from high school to the academic pace and rigor at the University level can stretch many students and sometimes lead to grades lower than they expected. As an example of our commitment to helping students get back on track academically, we are pleased to pilot the On-Track Summer Grant program for students meeting the established criteria this summer quarter 2024.

First-year, undergraduate students that entered SU in either Fall 2023 or Winter 2024 that received a D+, D, D-, F or W grade in two or more courses are eligible to receive a **Seattle University On-Track Summer Grant, equivalent to the cost of tuition for two undergraduate summer courses**. The On-Track Summer Grant may only be applied to courses taken this summer quarter 2024 and is not transferable to other academic terms. Mandatory fees in the amount of \$367 (Wellness fee of \$166 + Technology fee of \$201) for the summer quarter still apply and are not covered by the On-Track Summer grant.

Eligible students for this pilot were sent a message on Wednesday, April 3rd and are encouraged to schedule a meeting with their academic advisor to discuss what summer course/s being offered would be most beneficial for their major or academic interests. Most summer courses are offered on-line so students that will not be in Seattle or with other summer commitments can still access this opportunity. 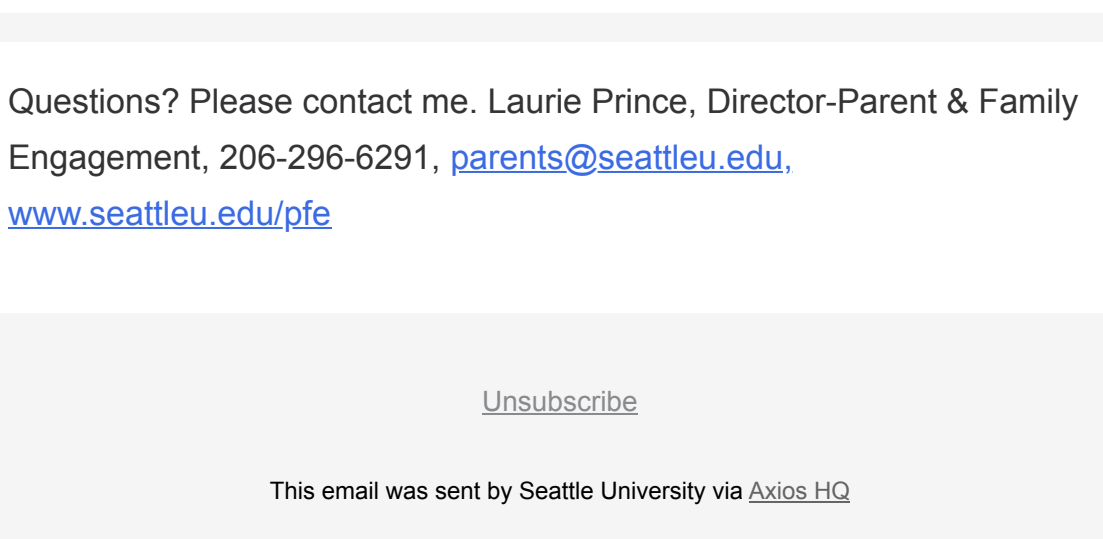

THIRD PARTY ACCESS TO STUDENT FINANCIAL INFORMATION:

There are two types of suggested access that students may give to parents or supporters.

Proxy Access allows family/supporter to speak to SFS Office about account status, balance, award letter, and required documentation.

Authorized User Access allows family/supporter login access view billing and payment information, setup payment plans, see tax documents, and get email notifications about billing invoicing.
