Objective

The Clinical Leaders Scholarship Program represents Seattle University's holistic definition of academic excellence, one that transcends classroom performance and encompasses the professional career and life of our Health Leadership Executive MBA students (HLEMBAs). The award is an \$18,000 scholarship dispersed equally over the 6 quarters of HLEMBAs.

Eligibility

Applicants for the Clinical Leaders Scholarship Program must have a:

- Bachelor of Science. Exceptions considered on an individual basis by the program director.
- Minimum of 10 years progressively responsible professional work experience. Applicants experience should reflect professional growth with a combination of clinical and administrative responsibilities.
- Demonstrated commitment to SU's Social Justice Mission (i.e. volunteerism, community service, etc.).
