### PROGRAM OVERVIEW

**The Nursing in Nicaragua course** will explore the history, culture & healthcare infrastructure of Nicaragua. Participants will spend three weeks working at a school for individuals with disabilities, interacting with students, their parents, and school staff. Opportunities for home visits or exploring other health service sites are also available. The immersion includes two cultural excursions within Nicaragua, including overnight travel to either Ometepe or Matagalpa.

Nicaraguan home with SU students and faculty

#### ESTIMATED COST:

Program fee is ~\$1,750. Students are responsible for airfare. Need-based financial support *may* be available

#### LANGUAGE OF INSTRUCTION:

English. Knowledge of Spanish is highly desirable.
