

SU CORE CURRICULUM WORKSHEET

FOR TRANSFER STUDENTS WITH 90 OR MORE CREDITS

All students completing a first undergraduate degree who have 90 transfer credits or more, will normally* complete a minimum of 21 core credits at Seattle University: PHIL210/220, THRS Phase II (200 level), interdisciplinary course, senior synthesis, and upper division ethics.

Transfer students who have not satisfied PHIL 110 with a transfer course will receive a waiver in PHIL 110. Students who transfer in with 90 credits or more will not be required to take a 300-level theology course.

*Students transferring to SU without a Direct Transfer Associate degree (DTA) from a Washington State community College may have additional Core requirements.

How to use this worksheet as a preliminary step to help you plan for the Core courses you will take:

1. As you review the Core requirements on the left, identify the course requirements you need to satisfy.
2. Use the Undergraduate Bulletin of Information in conjunction with this process, identifying course options, and consulting the section on your major for any additional requirements, exceptions, and/or stipulated courses you may have. Second Philosophy

A 5 credit course fulfills Core Philosophy requirement

- PHIL 220 Philosophy of the Human Person for students who have taken PHIL 110 at SU
OR
PHIL 210 for students who are not required to take PHIL 110 at SU

Theology Requirement

Select one 5 credit course from the THRS 200-299 menu of classes.
Students must take the 200 level Theology/Religious course before they take the 300 level.

Usually, all the THRS 200-299 course listings are "approved" Core options, but consult SU-Online course comments

Interdisciplinary Requirement

A 3 to 5 credit interdisciplinary course (one that deals with a contemporary issue from a multidisciplinary perspective) approved by the University CORE.

Major Exceptions:

Criminal Justice students, Business students, Diagnostic Ultrasound students and Engineering students have this requirement "fulfilled by major."

These approved offerings can be found on SU-Online's class search function, & usually are numbered 480-484.

Senior Synthesis Requirement

A course or project of 3 to 5 credits approved by the student's major department and the CORE director as fulfilling the objectives of the senior synthesis requirement.
