Terms and Conditions

Students enrolled in the China Study Tour – 2015 program are considered to be mature people who want to participate in the study abroad program because of genuine interest in the educational and cultural opportunities it provides. It is understood that each participant has a sense of personal responsibility in the success of the program and that each will exercise good judgment, respect the rights and feelings of others and subscribe to the laws and modes of conduct of the host country.

The following agreement is designed to clarify the obligations and expectations of the participants. All students must read this document carefully, sign and return it as an indication that the terms and conditions of the study abroad program are understood and acceptable.

1. I realize that any form of travel can be hazardous and, therefore, in the absence of negligence, release Seattle University and its officers and agents from any and all claims and causes of action for loss of property, personal injury, illness or death arising out of any travel or activity undertaken independently or conducted by or under the control of Seattle University and its officers and agents.
2. I will determine if my medical insurance covers me during travel outside the United States. If it does not, I will obtain a supplemental policy for the duration of the study tour.
3. I understand that the program leaders, directors, and faculty are acting solely in their capacities as agents of Seattle University and I agree to waive any and all claims against them individually for losses occasioned by any delays in arrival or departure of air flights or for the failure, due to bankruptcy or otherwise, of any of the companies providing transportation, hotel, food or program services.
4. I understand that Seattle University reserves the right to make cancellations, or to change the agenda or program, faculty, flight arrangements or other services, in case of emergencies or changed conditions or in the interest of the group.
5. I understand that it is up to individual participants to obtain and keep in force their own health insurance while out of the country. I further understand that I am financially responsible for my own medical expenses and that any advance payments made by the program directors or faculty on my behalf shall be immediately reimbursed.
6. I understand that I am responsible for obtaining and keeping safe my passport, money, travelers checks, travel tickets, jewelry, and other property.
7. In the event of illness or injury I hereby authorize the program directors or faculty to obtain whatever emergency or medical treatment is deemed necessary, including anesthetics or other medication and surgery, and I hereby assume the cost of such treatment.
8. I am aware of the Study Tour program schedule and I am aware of the costs involved. I further understand that if I cancel my participation in the program I will not be entitled to a refund of any moneys paid in. Students who feel they may need to cancel may wish to obtain private trip cancellation insurance.
9. I understand that all students are subject to Seattle University regulations, policies and codes of conduct.
10. I understand that all travel on the tour will be with the group. I understand that individual lodging arrangements are not permitted, that all lodging, including weekends will be with the group, and that all lodging will be double occupancy. Travel extensions may be arranged for dates following the tour.
11. I understand that failure to meet a deadline for document submission or progress payments is cause for removal from the study tour.
12. I agree to attend pre-departure class meetings and a post-trip session.
