**Nonprofit Leadership Minor**

In order to earn a Minor in Nonprofit Leadership, students must complete 30 credits, with a cumulative grade point average of 2.00. Students will complete four required courses (20 credits) and two elective courses (10 credits). Electives may be taken outside of the program with the approval of the nonprofit leadership advisor. Internships are available and will count toward a student’s general elective credits.

Nonprofit Leadership courses are offered once a year. Interested students should meet with the nonprofit leadership advisor to discuss a course plan to complete the minor.
