Mission

To support the professional formation of mid-to-senior level professionals in the health sector in pursuit of the Health Leadership EMBA (HLEMBA).

Objective

The Health Leadership EMBA Program reflects Seattle University's holistic definition of academic excellence, one that transcends classroom performance and encompasses the professional careers and lives of our HLEMBA students. Multiple scholarships are available and range from \$10,000-\$18,000. The total award is dispersed equally across the 6 quarters of HLEMBA.

This scholarship is designed to support health leaders whose professional experience reflects their commitment to many/all of the following:

- Academic Excellence
- Service and Leadership
- Community
- Global Engagement

Eligibility

Applicants for the Health Leadership EMBA Scholarship Program must be applying for or admitted to the first year of the program. Applicants must have a:

- Bachelor's degree from a four year regionally-accredited institution. Exceptions considered on an individual basis by the program director.
- Minimum of 10 years progressively responsible professional work experience. Applicant's experience should reflect professional growth with a combination of clinical and administrative responsibilities.
- Demonstrated commitment to Seattle University's Social Justice Mission (i.e. volunteerism, community service, etc.).

Scholarship Application Deadlines

The Scholarship application process occurs in two rounds, as follows:

- First round applications are due June 30, 2014. Decisions will be communicated by July 15, 2014.
- Second round applications are due August 1, 2014. Decisions will be communicated by August 8, 2014.
 - Applicants who are not awarded a scholarship during first round will be automatically considered for a scholarship in the second round.

To be considered, applicant must be applying for or admitted to the first year of the program. Applicant must meet the eligibility requirements noted above, **and** have a completed application for admission and all supporting documentation on file with Seattle University Graduate Admissions, or submit with the scholarship application.
