## **International Student Declaration of Finances (GRADUATE)**

*U.S. Immigration requires that Seattle University verify the financial resources of all international applicants who intend to hold an F-1 student visa. This form is for that purpose. The estimated total cost of attendance as determined on page 3 is for one academic year (3 quarters/9 months). You are required to provide evidence of sufficient financial resources to meet or exceed the estimated total cost of attendance (minus any scholarship being offered by the University).*

*Please note that international students are not authorized to work in the United States except under special circumstances or through part-time on-campus employment. On-campus jobs are not guaranteed, and you should not plan on supporting your education through employment while being a student.*

### **INSTRUCTIONS**

Please fill out pages 2 and 3 of this form completely, including signatures. Incomplete forms will be returned to you. In addition to completing this Declaration of Finances form, international students must provide evidence of the financial support being indicated on page 3. Such evidence is typically provided through current bank statements or bank letters.

#### **Guidelines for financial documents:**

- “Current balance” must be dated within the last six months.
- The name of the bank and of the account holder must be included.
- The current total account balance must be shown (we cannot accept a letter indicating only “adequate funds,” “balance in the low six figures,” “good customer,” etc.).
- The type of currency must be indicated. (Showing a balance in US dollars is not required; we can do the conversion.)
- The type of account (e.g. savings, checking) must be indicated.
- Assets must be liquid, not stocks or property.
- Documents should be in English or include an English translation.
- Photocopies or scanned copies of signatures and bank documents are acceptable.
- Letters of financial guarantee from government or other institutional sponsors or lenders must include the name of the award/loan recipient, state the period of time covered by the award/loan, include the name and position of the authorized signing representative, and indicate Seattle University as the student’s authorized institution of attendance.
- Personal sponsors other than immediate family members may be required to submit an additional letter of support. Information about the content of this letter will be provided by Seattle University International Graduate Admissions staff.

#### **Other Guidelines:**

- Living expenses generally will not be waived for I-20 issuance, even if you have made off-campus living arrangements.
- The estimated total cost does not include transportation to and from the United States. It also does not include living expenses for your annual vacation period (typically the summer months). If you will remain in the U.S. during your vacation term, please take this into consideration.
- Estimated tuition amounts shown are for one academic year consisting of a minimum of 6 credits per quarter for three quarters. Some programs may require more credits per quarter or an additional fourth quarter, so please plan accordingly.
