



In order to progress into the nursing sequence courses (NURS) in the winter of the sophomore year for SU traditional students or in the fall of the junior year for transfer students, all prerequisite courses must be completed.

Additionally the student must maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.75 and a GPA of 3.0 in the nursing prerequisite courses before an accepted student may enroll in any undergraduate nursing program course.


