Application Instructions and Procedures

All application materials must be received by the application deadline to receive full consideration. For application deadlines and entry terms, refer to the [priority deadlines](#). *International applicants and those with international transcripts should consult the [International Requirements Page](#), for deadlines and other requirements, as they may differ.*

- A completed application form with a non-refundable \$55 application fee. Fee waived for Seattle University alumni.
- Successful completion of at least 7 months of Pastoral Leadership Certificate at Seattle University, including demonstrated capacity to conduct discipline appropriate research.
- Master of Divinity or its equivalent from an accredited institution. Equivalency and substitutions determined at discretion of Admissions Committee. Ministerial experience not considered equivalent of, or substitute for MDiv degree.
- Official transcripts of all graduate-level coursework are also required reflecting minimum grade point average of 3.0 cumulative on a scale of 4.0 is required.
- Evidence of minimum of three years of full-time professional ministerial experience subsequent to MDiv degree or its equivalent. In March-April of Post-master's Certificate in Pastoral Leadership year, interview with Director of DMin to chart course for either completion of the PMC-PL or DMin.
- If planning to study on an F-1 student visa, a completed Seattle University Declaration of Finance form is required.
