Credits: minimum of 135 credits

CURRICULUM NOTES

- Humanities Core includes UCOR 1800, UCOR 3800, and either HUMT 1450 or HUMT 1460.
- A student chooses an area of concentration or academic focus, which counts 40-45 credits toward the degree.
- The degree can be earned in three years for 135 credits, and a second degree can be earned with the addition of 35-45 credits in the fourth year for a minimum total of 180 credits.
- The additional 35-45 credits are posted toward the second degree.
- The Humanities Core replaces the University Core in the student's second degree.
