- The art piece can be an individual or group project
 - Each participant may contribute to only one art project submission, whether it is a group project or an individual submission
- The art piece may be submitted under one of the following categories:
 - Literature (essay, poetry, drama, or a story)
 - Visual arts (painting, drawing, collage, or sculpture)
 - Graphic arts (photography, design, and other forms expressed digitally)
- All projects should be safe to handle (no hazards, etc.) along with being socially and culturally appropriate
- The art piece must be composed of recycled, salvaged or collected litter materials, or express sentiments on the subject matter

Judging Criteria

Winning submissions will be scored based on the following criteria for each category:

- Originality/creativity
- Theme
- Material usage
- Relevance to personal and/or SU campus waste
