ALTERNATIVE ROUTES TO TEACHER CERTIFICATION

with an English Language Learners Endorsement /
Special Education Endorsement (Pending Approval)

Alternative Routes tends to be shorter, more convenient, more affordable, and more practically oriented.

Washington State has four alternative routes that cater to specific populations. All four routes lead to full residency certification - the first level regular teaching certificate.

Route 2: For district staff and paraprofessionals with a bachelor's degree

Route 3: For "career changers" with a bachelor's degree

Route 4: For district staff with a bachelor's degree and a limited certificate

Prerequisites

- Bachelor's Degree
- Attempt WEST-B and WEST-E Exam
- District support to ensure ELL residency placement

Program Duration

One academic year - Summer 2020 to Summer 2021
36 credits required for K-8 certification with ELL endorsement

Application Period

Application Opens: January 15, 2020
Priority Deadline: May 15, 2020

Program Cost

\$400 per credit - with BA path
