

Updated Travel Guidance

November 24, 2021

FACULTY and STAFF

- Per CDC guidance on [domestic](#) and [international](#) travel, Seattle University related travel is permitted for fully vaccinated individuals.
- In limited circumstances where essential University business requires travel, individuals who are not fully vaccinated are permitted to travel if they receive prior written approval from their supervisor or dean.
- The CDC recommends that you get tested with a COVID-19 viral test 3-5 days after travel. Self-monitor for COVID-19 symptoms; isolate and get tested if you develop symptoms.
 - If you are not fully vaccinated, the CDC recommends in addition to the testing recommendations above:
 - Stay home and self-quarantine for a full 7 days after travel, even if you test negative at 3-5 days.
 - If you don't get tested, stay home and self-quarantine for 10 days after travel.
- Travelers should follow CDC, airline, state, local and country-specific guidance and requirements.
