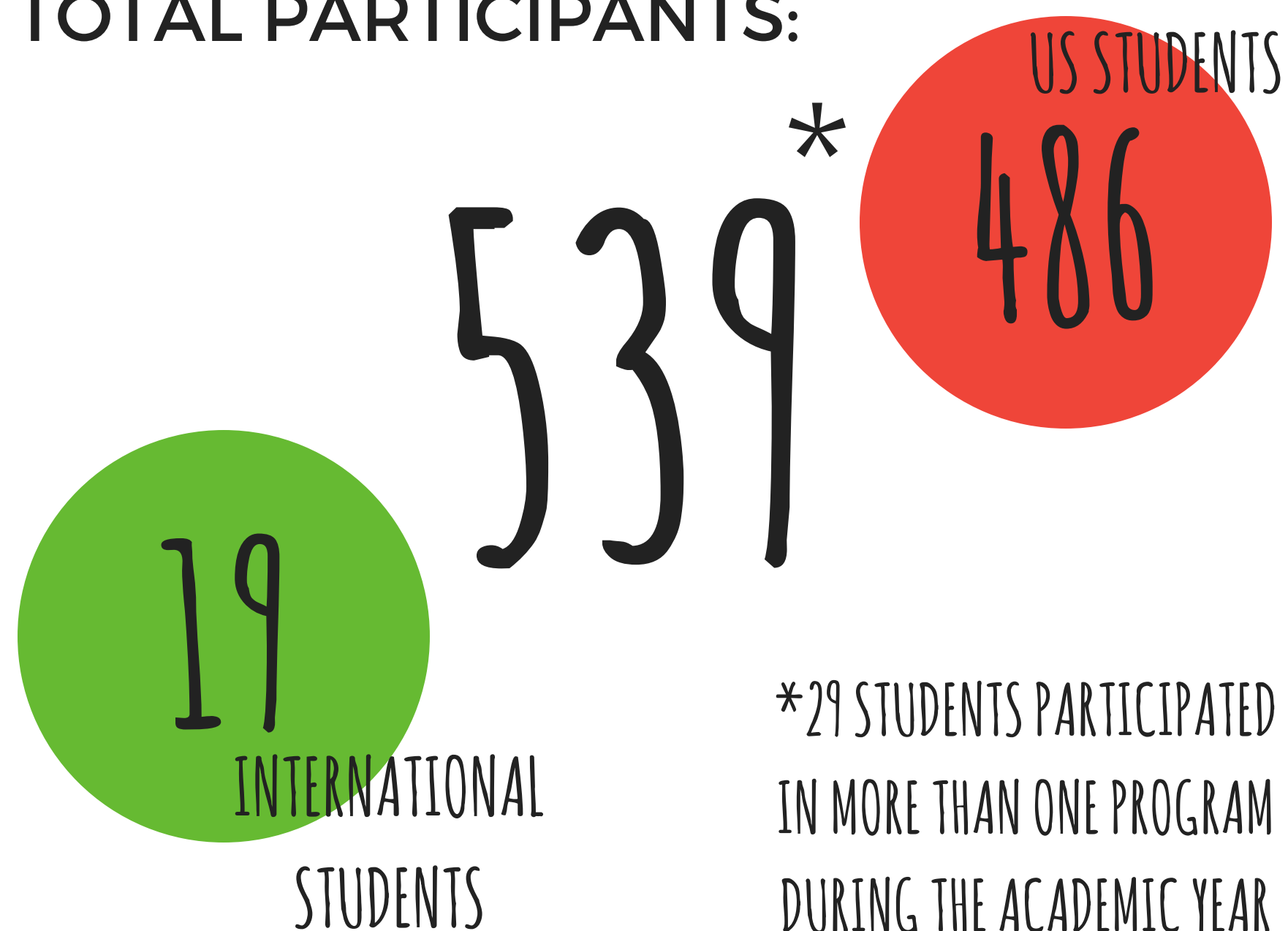

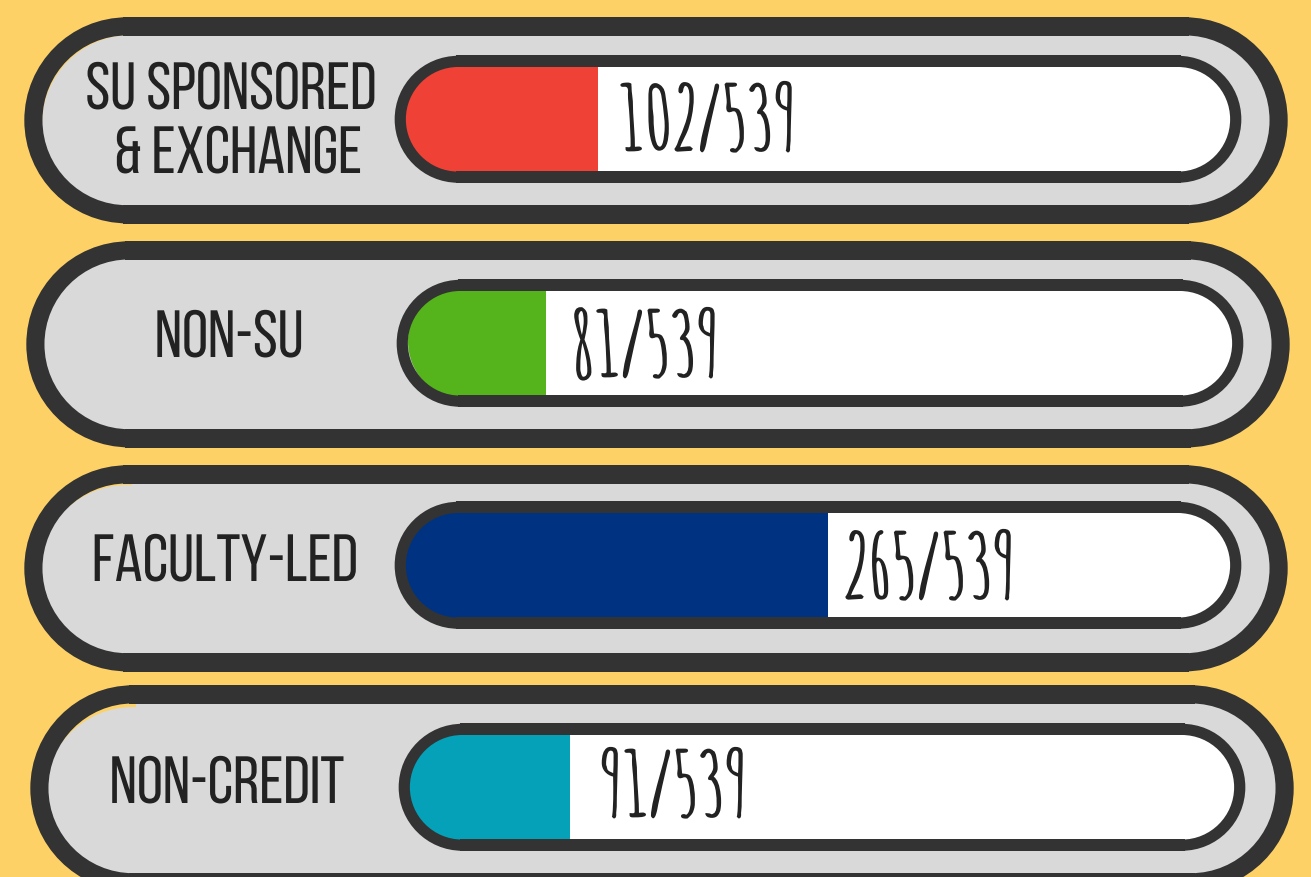
International programs at Seattle University are divided into five categories:

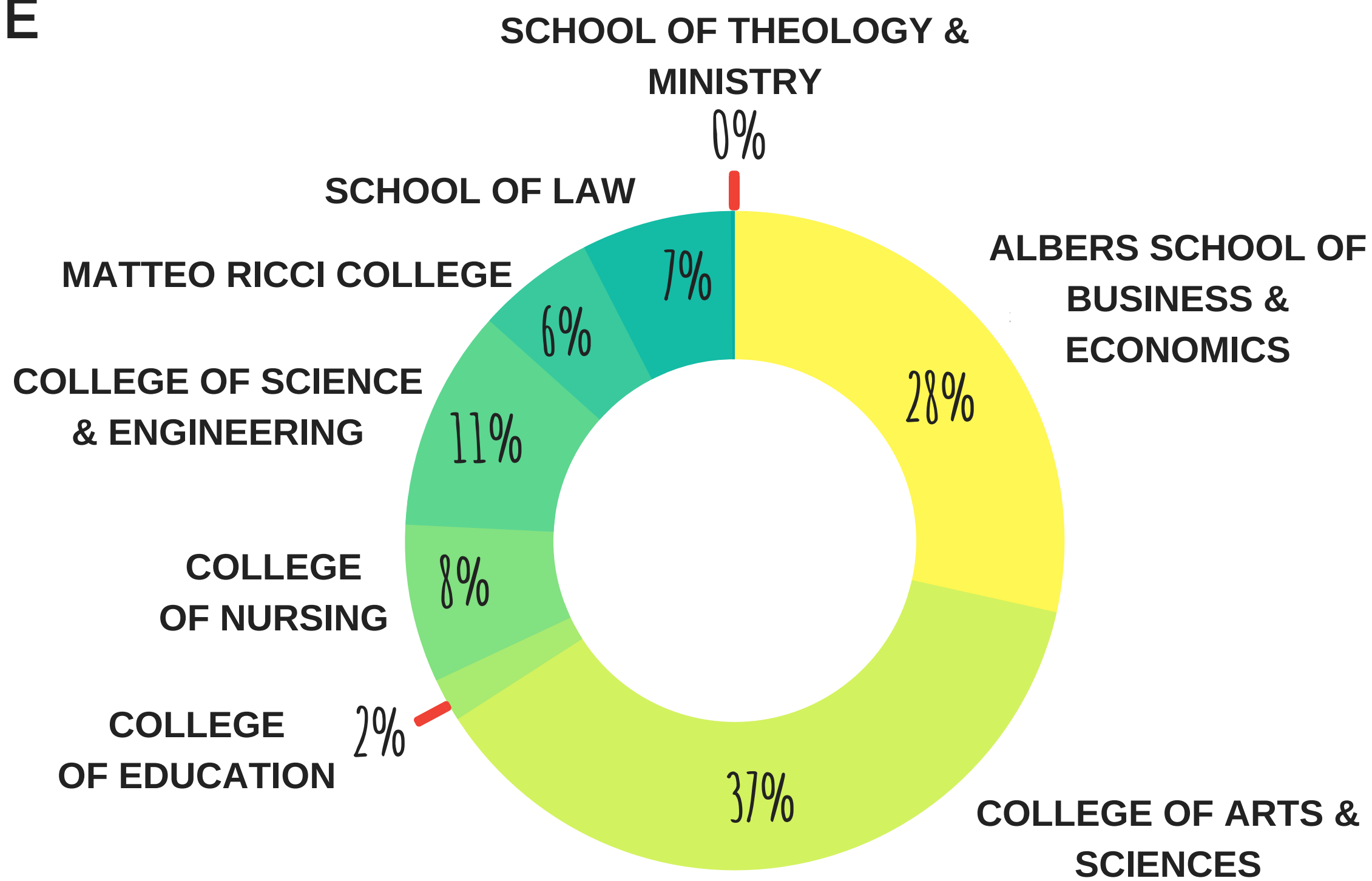


PROGRAM TYPE

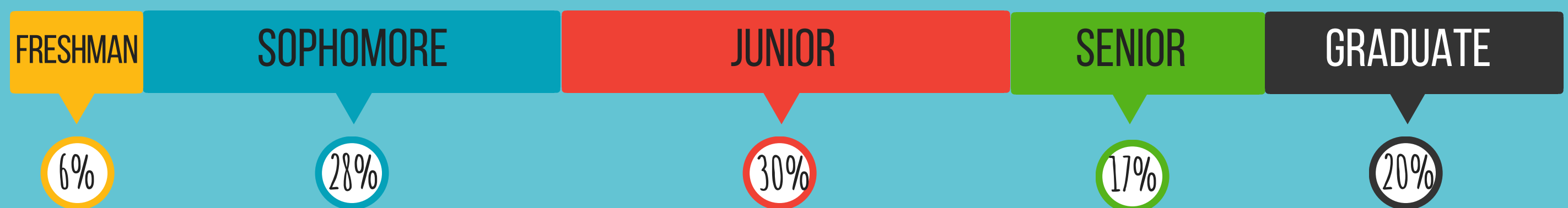

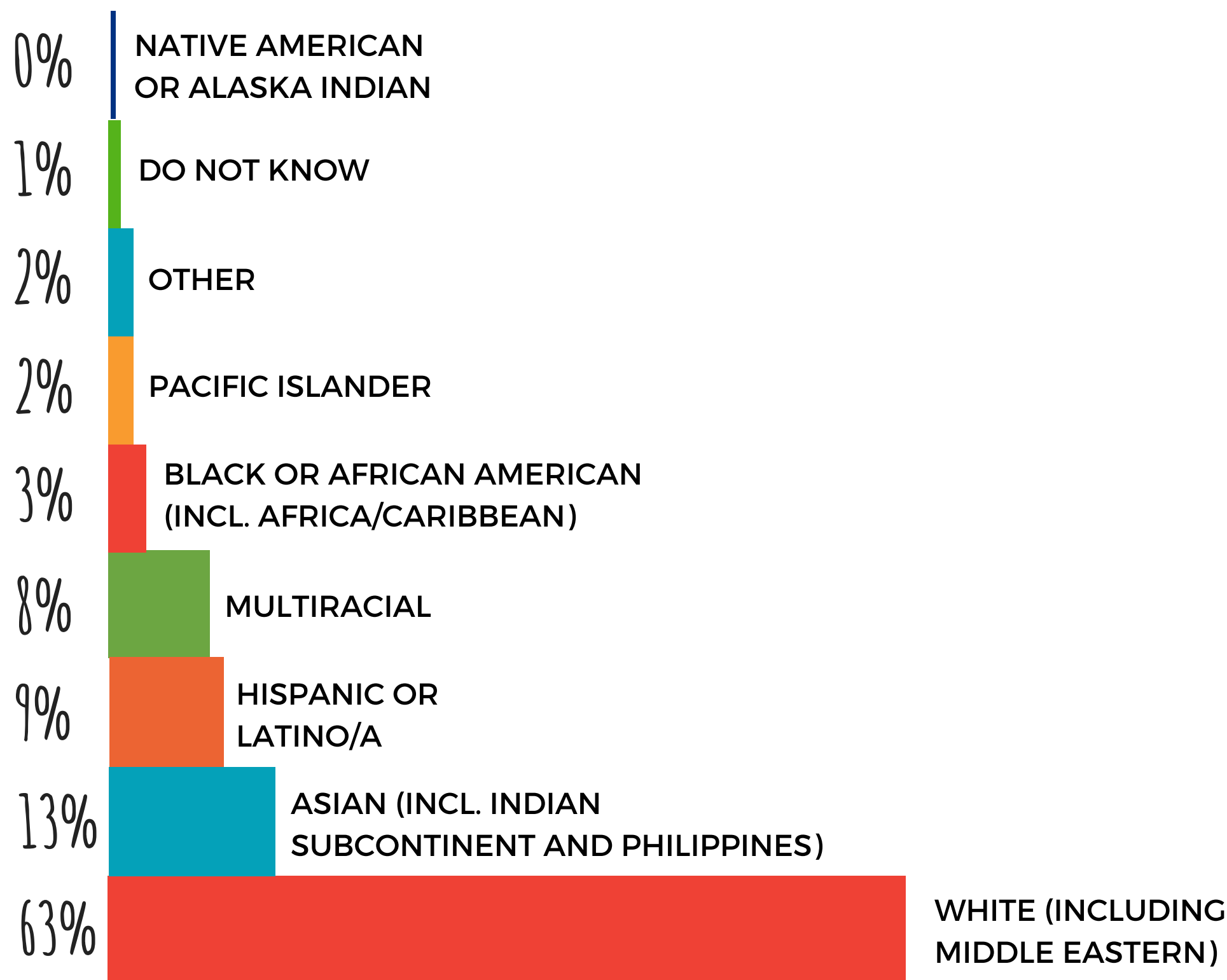


TOP 5 DESTINATIONS:

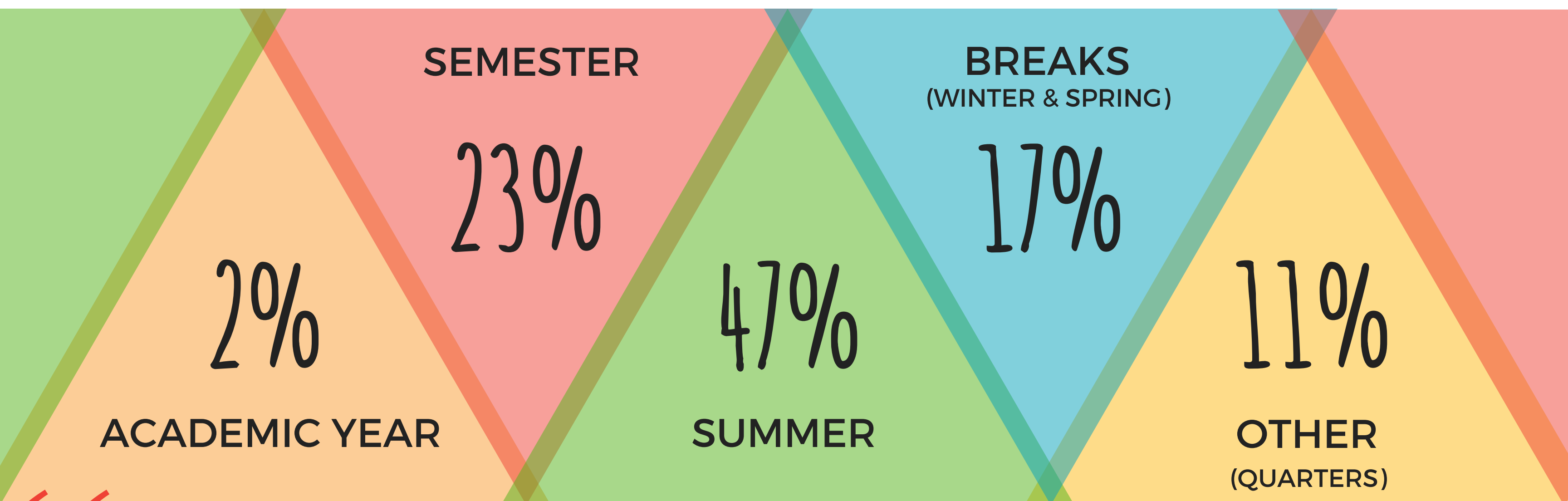
