



## LONG-TERM STUDY ABROAD PROGRAM COST COMPARISON WORKSHEET

**DIRECTIONS:** Use this worksheet to look at the *estimated* costs of your chosen study abroad program versus studying on campus at SU. Add up the *Cost at SU* and *Cost of Program* columns separately to identify A.) *Total Program Costs* and B.) *Total Aid Applied*. Next, subtract B.) *Total Aid Applied* from A.) *Total Program Costs* ( $A - B = \text{Program Cost}$ ). This will give you the costs of staying on campus or studying abroad to compare when deciding whether you can afford to study on the program you selected.
