| Personal Spending | Personal spending depends on your lifestyle. May include toiletries, clothing, nights out, souvenirs, etc. | |
| Medical/Travel Insurance | Estimated expense \$50 per month. Check to see if your program fee includes insurance. | |
| International Student Identification Card | The cost of the ISIC card is \$25.00. Check to see if your program fee includes the ISIC card. | |
| Passport | \$ 135.00 for a new passport and \$110.00 to renew your passport | |
| Visa | Cost of visa plus necessary photos and other documents and/or travel expenses. | |
