



## International Program Medical Report Instructions for Students and Healthcare Providers

In preparation for an education abroad experience, students are required to complete an International Program Medical Report by **June 1, 2020** (modified date due to COVID-19 restrictions) for participation in Fall 2020 Exchange programs. Instructions for both students and healthcare providers are below.

### **STUDENT INSTRUCTIONS**

1. At this time, you may not be able to visit your healthcare provider in person due to physical distancing as a result of COVID-19 precautions. If this is the case, you will need to schedule a virtual or phone visit and be sure your healthcare provider has a copy of this form prior to your visit.
2. Complete and sign Part I of the International Program Medical Report **before** giving it to your health care provider.
3. Plan in advance with your health care provider to have them complete PART II of this form and return it by June 1, 2020 to:

4. Give Parts I and II to your health care provider in accordance with the advanced arrangements (mail, drop-off, email, etc.) you agreed upon.
5. The Seattle University Student Health Center remains open during spring quarter and can provide healthcare to students who are currently living in Washington State. You can schedule appointments for travel physicals after May 4, 2020. These appointments will ideally be in person but if the Stay at Home order is extended your appointment will convert to a virtual visit. To schedule your appointment please call 206-296-6300.

### **HEALTHCARE PROVIDER INSTRUCTIONS**

This patient is a student at Seattle University planning to participate in an education abroad exchange program in Fall 2020 and has been asked to provide you with the International Program Medical Report prior to your visit. We ask that you:

1. Complete the report and return it to the physical or email address above by June 1, 2020.
2. If you are unable to complete the actual form, an alternative option is to provide a letter on your office letterhead which addresses all the questions on the health form.
