Otherwise, keep an eye out for email announcements and updates. **We will register a Paris 2022 class in mid-February.**

Everyone is welcome! *Americans in Paris* has been taught since 1990. The course focuses on the Rise of Modernism in Paris, in art, literary history, cinema, architecture, fashion, and so much else. Think great museums, walks in culturally diverse neighborhoods, a city-wide music festival, Gay Pride parade, street markets, lively discussions in the Luxembourg gardens – capped by your own *independent research or creative project*, including video-making.

No additional tuition! Register in **Spring Quarter** for either ENGL 4550 or FILM 4550 as your 4th course overload. We meet only four early evenings on campus, plus a French Dinner meeting at Dr. Weihe's home. Then we head for **Paris (June 17- July 1st)** and our Left Bank hotel near the Sorbonne campus. Our work in Paris will include regular meetings in the Luxembourg Gardens and guided *Paris Walkbook* journal writing assignments. Optional excursions to Giverny, Versailles, and Chartres!

Travel Costs The 14 night \$950 hotel cost, \$475 course fee, and \$40 travel insurance are added to your regular Spring Quarter tuition bill. Otherwise, *you manage your own travel costs*, which include estimated airfare (\$900-\$1200), food (\$500+/-), local transportation and museums (\$120), drinks and misc. (\$200+/-). Total cost, including hotel and course fee, is normally **\$3600 +/-, but you're in charge!**

AFTER Paris A study-abroad course in **IRELAND**, taught by Dr. Sean McDowell, begins immediately after the Paris course. Look for **Ireland information meetings** this Fall.
