Welcome to the **Seattle University Housing Portal**.

This portal will be your one stop shop for applying for housing and all things related to your housing requests. Below is a list of items you will be able to do on here.

Application - From here you will be able to fill out a housing application to live on-campus. Please select the appropriate term you would like to fill out an application for. Signing at the end of the application will give you a confirmation of your application status. *Obtaining a housing exemption from the live in requirement, can be found in the application process.*

Early Arrival/Late Departure - From this tab, you will need to select the term session (Quarter) you are requesting for. Keep in mind that if you do not have a reservation (Early Arrival), or are currently in-room (Late Departure), you will not be able submit a request. Once you receive a booking, you will be able to submit a request.

Requests Tab:

- **Add Meal Plan** - If you do not currently have a meal plan, and would like one to be added to your Seattle University ID Card, select this option. This will be charged to your student account.
- **Change Meal Plan Request** - If you would like to change your current meal plan, select this option. Please keep in mind *restrictions apply*, and requests can only be considered only within the first 10 days of classes of each quarter.
- **Cancellation of Application/Housing** - If you have decided that you no longer wish to live on campus after filling out an application, or receiving an assignment, use this form. Keep in mind that this is a request, and confirmation will be sent, if applicable. *If you are looking to be exempt from the live in requirement, you can find this option in the application.*

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Housing Requirement Notification

Seattle University Students are required to live on campus and purchase **The Residential Meal Plan** if you fall into any of the following categories:

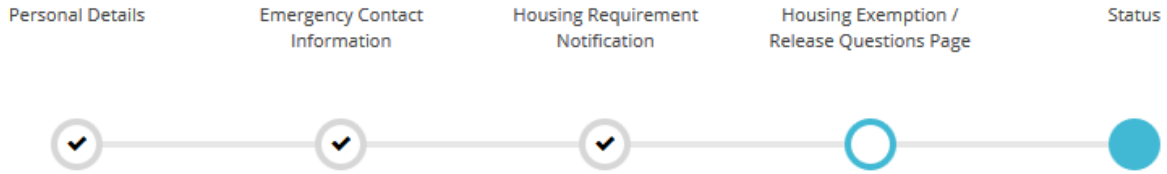
- Freshman or Sophomore and under the age of 21
- First or Second year SU student and under the age of 21
- Within 2 years of High School graduation date as of the first day of fall quarter, and under

If you fall into any of the above categories (as of the first day of class for the academic year), you are required to live on campus for the FULL ACADEMIC YEAR. If student status (class year, age etc.) changes during the academic year, you will not be released from this housing requirement until the following academic year.

You can apply to be exempt from our residential requirement, if you are **living with family** in a commutable distance from Seattle University. This is roughly in a 20 mile radius from Seattle University.

Housing Exemption / Release Questions Page

It looks like you are planning on living at home, or with a family member in the local area. Please read more detailed information below as to our specifics on our policy.

You must live with the **family** member in their **primary place of residence** (approx 20 miles or less from campus, please see SU Commutable Distance Map for reference).

- **Family** is defined as a parent, aunt, uncle, grandparent, spouse, or children.
- **Primary place of residence** is defined as a person's true, fixed, and permanent home and place of habitation, to the exclusion of all others. It is the place where the person intends to remain permanently.

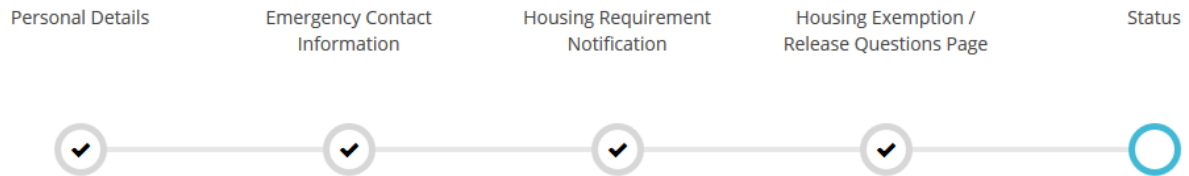
