



FACHEX and Tuition Exchange: Application Status

Seattle University participates in the FACHEX and Tuition Exchange tuition remission programs, available to undergraduate dependents children of Seattle University employees who have at least three years of full-time uninterrupted service with the University.

FACHEX is a tuition remission program involving the 26 Jesuit colleges and universities in the United States, excluding Georgetown.

Tuition Exchange is a similar program within a network of over 600 educational institutions nationwide.

After your child's applications have been submitted, both the parent and child can check on the status of the applications by following these instructions.

Checking the Application Status	
Step 1	Visit https://www.tuitionexchange.org/ .
Step 2	Click "Application Status" under the "Families" tab.
Step 3	Provide the last 4 digits of your child's social security number, date of birth and the email address provided on the applications.
Step 4	Press the "Check Application Status" button.
Step 5	Review the status. Most applications will say 'decision pending' or 'wait listed' prior to the institutions awarding applicants.
