

GRADE POINT AVERAGE REQUIREMENTS FOR DEGREE COMPLETION

BACHELOR DEGREES

Major GPA

A minimum cumulative Seattle University grade point average of 2.00 is required in the major in order for a student to be eligible for a degree except in those programs outlined below, which require a higher minimum GPA. For purposes of this policy, the student's major courses are considered to include all Seattle University credits used to complete course and credit requirements of the major department as well as the supporting courses in allied fields specifically required by the department. This includes courses used in the major program which are also allowed to satisfy core requirements.

Graduate students must maintain a B average and must have a minimum 3.00 cumulative GPA in order to earn a master's, educational specialist, or doctoral degree.
