FIELD EXPERIENCE VALIDATION

The College of Arts and Sciences may validate previously completed field experience presented by students and grant credit toward the degree using its credit by examination procedures. Approval of the dean and department chair is required, with the maximum credits granted not to exceed the total field experience credits required in a degree program, with an absolute maximum of 20 quarter credits. The fee for validation of field experience will be as specified on the Tuition and Fees page of the *Undergraduate Catalog*. The validation of previous field experience may require reporting, oral or written examinations, references and outside evaluations by qualified professionals, or any combination of the above.

Requirements and procedures for qualifying for the credit by examination option as published in the *Undergraduate Catalog* apply to students wishing to validate previously completed field experience.
