

GRADUATION AWARDS FOR UNDERGRADUATES*

Awards

All students graduating with a 4.0 GPA, who took at least 90 credits at Seattle University, will receive the Seattle University Award for Academic Excellence. This includes both First Time in College and Transfers.

Two special awards will be given at commencement. Unless there are special circumstances, one person will receive each award.

President's Award: Academic Excellence and Leadership presented to the outstanding graduating senior who has attended Seattle University beginning as a First Time in College and who has earned a 4.0 GPA.

Provost's Award: Academic Excellence and Leadership presented to the outstanding transfer student who has taken at least 90 credits while at Seattle University and who has earned a 4.0 GPA. Study abroad credits may be included.

Selection Process

Each undergraduate dean will submit a nominee for each of the two awards from the list of recipients of the Award for Academic Excellence (4.0 GPA), (with the exception of NCS for the President's Award). The deans will then decide, as a group, the recipient of each award. This process follows the process for granting of the graduate student academic award.
