\* Seattle University bills the premium for annual student health insurance to all undergraduate students as a mandatory fee each quarter. Insurance coverage may be waived, if the student has comparable coverage in Washington State, by going to mySeattleU and clicking on their username in upper corner, then Student Insurance Waiver and following the instructions on the insurance portal.

\*\* The Enrollment Confirmation Deposit is a confirmation of intended enrollment for new Undergraduates for Fall Quarter. It will be applied to the tuition charges for fall. Students who decide not to attend SU after submitting a confirmation deposit will be eligible for a \$200 refund until August 1st.

Students attending for Winter or Spring Quarter are not required to submit tuition deposits.

# Cost of Attendance and Financial Need

To prepare a student's financial aid award, the Student Financial Services Office subtracts the Expected Family Contribution (EFC) as calculated from the information provided on the student's FAFSA, from the estimated cost of attendance, often referred to as the student budget, to determine financial need.

Following are sample student budgets for the **2021-22 nine-month academic year for full-time students**, undergraduates enrolled for 12-20 credits, and graduate students enrolled for 6 credits:
