

GRADE POINT AVERAGE REQUIREMENTS

UNDERGRADUATE

Undergraduate students must maintain a minimum 2.00 cumulative and major GPA to remain in good academic standing and to earn a bachelor's degree. Major GPA is calculated only once a student has earned at least 15 graded credits at Seattle University in the major.

Students earning a minor must earn a minimum 2.00 GPA in any declared minor to earn that minor.

GRADUATE

Graduate students must maintain a minimum 3.00 cumulative GPA to remain in good academic standing and to earn a master's, educational specialist, or doctoral degree.
