Advising Continuing Students: University Core

Cornish Transition Worksheet 2027-2028

CCA Students will transition to the Seattle University Core Curriculum (UCOR) in Summer Semester 2027.

Current students can use this worksheet along with their Program Evaluation to plan which Core courses they will need after Spring 2027.

In the column labeled “Current Gen Eds”:

1. If you have a course planned between now and Spring 2027, make note of which term you will take it, but don’t mark the check box until the course is completed.
2. Mark the check box for courses already taken in the Cornish General Education Requirements.

Each row needs one course checked to be satisfied and courses cannot double-count. If a requirement is not satisfied by end of Spring Quarter 2027, you will take a University Core Course to fulfill the requirement.

No CCA-SU student will be required to take additional UCOR courses beyond the total number of Gen Eds they were required to take at matriculation.
