Advising Continuing Students New Core Transition Worksheet 2027-2028

The New University Core Curriculum will launch in Summer Semester 2027. Current students can use this worksheet along with their Program Evaluation to plan which Core courses they will need after Spring Quarter 2027.

In the right-hand column labeled “Current Core Course Substitution”:

1. If you have a course planned between now and Spring 2027, make note of which quarter you will take it, but don’t mark the check box until the course is completed.
2. Mark the check box for courses already taken or satisfied in Current Core. If a course is noted as “satisfied in major” on your current Program Evaluation, it will be satisfied in the major for the new Core so you can check it off.

Each row needs one course checked to be satisfied. If not satisfied by end of Spring Quarter 2027, you will take the new Core Course number.

* If you have completed **one** UCOR 3400, 3600 or 3800 Global Challenges, that will satisfy UCOR 3200. If you have completed **two** from UCOR 3400, 3600 or 3800 Global Challenges, the second will satisfy UCOR 3300. Transfer students who have had one Global Challenges waived will maintain a waiver and only be required to take one of either UCOR 3200 or UCOR 3300. **If you have not completed any Global Challenges but you have completed a language requirement above what is required for your college, UCOR 3200 may be fulfilled, provided the language was taken at SU and you are not majoring in the language.
