Academic Calendar Review will sponsor an advisory referendum on calendar models April 7-16. Faculty and staff will vote. The results along with ACR findings will be shared with the Provost before he makes a recommendation to the President. The President then makes a recommendation to the Board of Trustees who makes the final determination on whether to keep or change our academic calendar.
