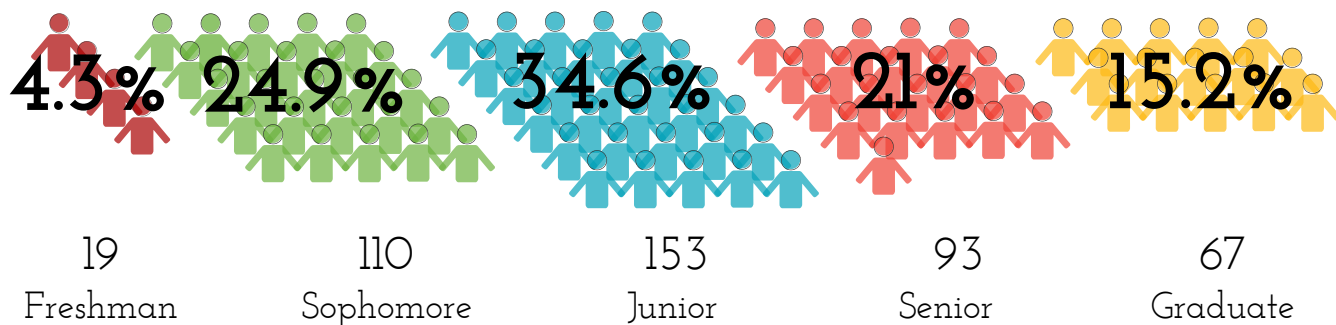

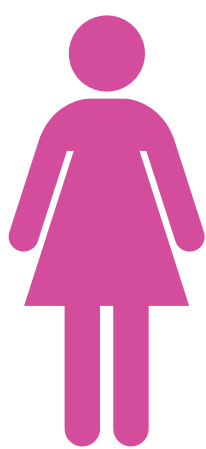


ACADEMIC STANDING

As identified on passport

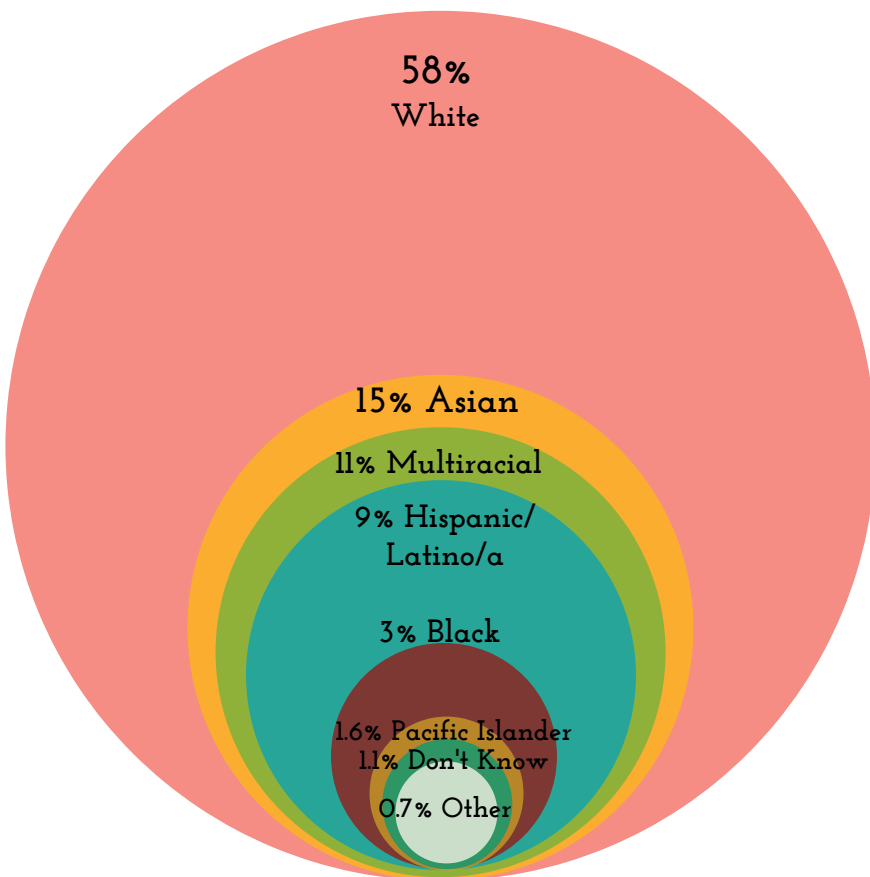
