Step 1: View your Status Update

- After your application has gone through the full review process, you will receive an e-mail notifying you to check your **Applicant Status Portal** for an important status update
- Using the credentials you created when you applied to SU, log in to the portal and click 'View Update' to view your decision letter






Transfer Credit Evaluation Overview

- Review the <u>Transfer Credit Policy</u> to better understand how credits are evaluated






Transfer Credit Evaluation View your total Transfer Credits






Transfer Credit Evaluation View Specific UCOR & Major Requirements






Transfer Credit Evaluation University Core: Module II






Step 5: View your Transfer Credit Summary
